QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Any undergraduate or graduate level student enrolled in the field of Construction Management or Civil Engineering in the University of Pittsburgh's School of Engineering and meeting the following qualification criteria is eligible to apply.
- 2. Applicants must have completed thirty (30) credit hours of undergraduate education and be a full time student pursuing a degree in the field of Construction Management or Civil Engineering in the University of Pittsburgh's School of Engineering.
- 3. Applicants must submit complete official university transcripts of grades to date.
- 4. Scholarship awards are competitive and may be based on:
 - Academic standing as determined by university grades in the Department;
 - Career choice as it relates to the construction industry;
 - Extracurricular activities and leadership in both high school and college.
- 5. Family members of the CAP and MBA staff and members of the CAP Scholarship Committee will not be eligible for the awards.

SELECTIONS

- 1. Applicants must submit a completed application and supporting documents within the specified deadline to receive consideration for the scholarship.
- 2. Applicants are required to submit a personal letter giving qualifications for the scholarship, including a statement concerning their educational and career goals, and detailing their construction work experience.

RETENTION

- 1. The award will be forfeited if the applicant leaves the field of Construction Management or Civil Engineering in the University of Pittsburgh's School of Engineering.
- 2. The award will be forfeited if the applicant moves outside the state of Pennsylvania.
- 3. Any change in the educational status of the scholarship recipient must be reported to the Scholarship Committee.

PAYMENTS

1. The award will be made payable to the University of Pittsburgh, CAP/MBA Scholarship and be distributed to the recipient.

TERMINATION

1. CAP and MBA will have the right to revise, change or cancel the scholarship award program, as it deems necessary.

DEADLINES

- 1. Submission of completed applications and supporting documents must be made by December 7, 2012.
- 2. Award will be announced December 14, 2012.
