





FHA Redlining Example: Pittsburgh 1934




Red: areas of "highest risk'











Black History in Pittsburgh

Major Martin Delaney, first Black U.S. Army Field Officer (commissioned by Abraham Lincoln); one of first Blacks admitted to (but later dismissed from) Harvard Medical School; he and team of Black nurses treated victims of cholera epidemic in the city. First proponent of Black Nationalism

Established by Black Pittsburgh:

- Pittsburgh Crawfords
- Homestead Grays
- The Pittsburgh Courier (oldest Black newspaper in U.S.)
- NAACP
- Urban League





John B. Vashon, War of 1812 Veteran, richest black man in Pittsburgh in early 19th century





William Hunter Dammond BSCE 1893

Lena Horne, Early Jazz in Pittsburgh's Little Harlem (Hill District).

Jazz was brought via the rivers from New Orleans to Pittsburgh, which would become of the country's historic jazz centers of innovation and culture.



U.S. Small business impact during COVID-19


Black small businesses hit twice as hard as white ones






Inflation-Adjusted Published Tuition and Fees Relative to 1989-90, 1989-90 to 2019-20 (1989-90 = 1.0)




African American college students' six-year graduation rates are stagnant while others' rates are increasing




2050 Working Age Population




- U.S workforce will be 200 million strong by 2050 (164 million now)
