

ABET Outcome h

Seniors with international experiences during college had higher GPI scores on the *cognitive dimension* compared to seniors with no international experience, but scored lower in the *intrapersonal* and *interpersonal* dimensions

Seniors with international experience both before and during college had higher GPI scores on all three dimensions than the other three senior cohorts (although only marginally in the *cognitive dimension*).

In total 102/175 (58.3%) had some form of international experience in college by graduation.
