Dear Pitt u.lab hub community,

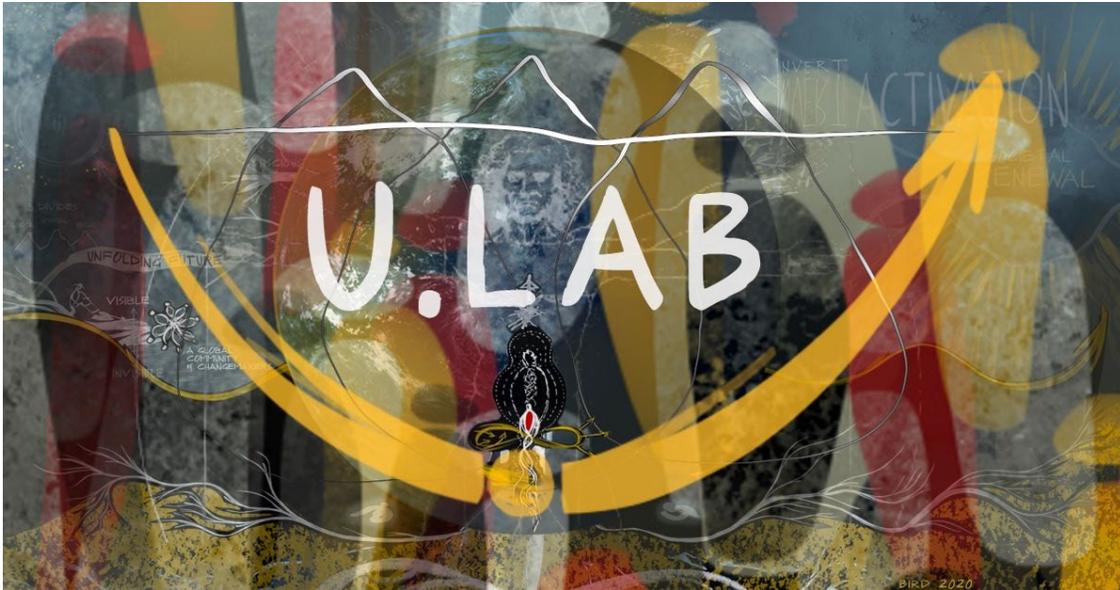

Please join us for the Adaptive Space course open house, and look forward to:

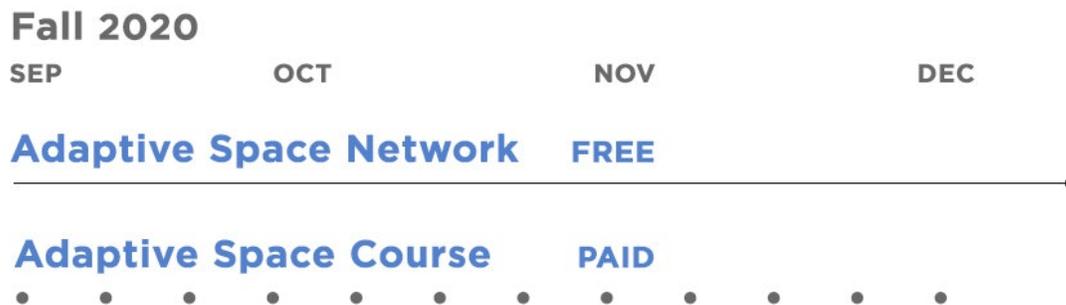

Adaptive Space Mighty Network

Adaptive Space (2020–21) is an evolution of the [Pitt u.lab hub](#) (2019–20). While continuing to serve Pitt u.lab hub’s original intention of supporting a learning community for the MITx MOOC [u.lab: Leading from the Emerging Future](#), the Adaptive Space program has developed capacity to offer much more. It is one step further in prototyping a holding space for personal, organizational and societal transformation in Pittsburgh.

There are two parts to the Adaptive Space fall 2020 program:

Within this network, we continue to offer **Pitt u.lab hub specific activities**, such as monthly live sessions that correspond with the u.lab MOOC, and coaching circles as close-knit peer support groups. In addition, we will also **host more activities to build stronger communities**. Along this line, we plan to host conversations with “local heroes”, profile projects from network members, lead book clubs, and conduct open inquiries on certain topics.
